

Code of Conduct Process Flow

Who is an eligible reporter?

- 1. Umpire (of the match)
- 2. CNSW CEO (or his or her designee)

The following people can report with leave from the Commissioner:

- 3. an Executive Officer/appointed official of either Association involved in the match
- 4. an Executive Officer/appointed official of the Association whom the Reported Person belongs to
- 5. a person who officiated in the Match during or in relation to which the alleged offence was committed who is a member of or related to either of the Clubs or Teams participating in the relevant Match
- 6. any other person

Deny the offence(s) and the sanction(s)

Hearing

Schedule A – General Offences
Level 1/2/3 = Commissioner
Level 4 = Judiciary Committee
Schedule B – Serious Offences
Level 1/2 = Commissioner
Level 3/4/5 = Judiciary Committee

Appeal

Level 1 (single offence) = Head of Integrity All other = Judiciary Committee Report (online form)

Commissioner conducts initial review

No case to answer – report dismissed

Notice of Charge

Admit the offence(s) but dispute the sanction(s)

Admit the offence(s) and accept the proposed sanction(s)
